
















### INTRODUCTION

The challenges facing development in Yemen are growing year by year, the majority of the population suffer from an increasing shortage in food and water, a worrying decline in health and education services, and security risks to the lives of most people in conflict and war zones.

According to UN and international reports that war in Yemen since 2015 has made about

22 million people in humanitarian need, where the majority of the population suffer from lack of food security and lack of basic services such as primary health care, drink water, and sanitation services, while more than ten million people are on the edge of famine.

These reports also confirm that acute malnutrition is threatening the lives of some 400,000 children.

All of these challenges have forced For **Human Foundation for Development** 

to provide support and implement development, relief and health projects and various development programs, based on its national and humanitarian duty and in contribution to the development and combating poverty in Yemen. the Foundation, since its establishment in 2015, does its best to provide the necessary and possible support to the beneficiaries of its services and activities in various governorates of the Republic, according to plans and policies studied, keep pace with all the desired developments in humanitarian and voluntary action. The Foundation strives to make quantum leaps to improve its performance and services, taking advantage of all the preceded experiences it in the field of humanitarian work, and investing all forms of cooperation and coordination with their local partners and international donors.

## Humanitarian Development

For Human Foundation for Development pays a great attention to the field of human development as it is the most important means for sustainable development in humanitarian work. The economic studies proved the feasibility of these projects in achieving self-sufficiency and providing continuous income for poor and displaced families in order to ensure a decent life. The development of these projects varies according to the nature of the families , what they can do with these support according to the accurate theoretical and field study by the team of the foundation including employees and volunteers.

### 1- Economic and community empowerment

Economic and social empowerment projects are one of the development projects that the foundation pays a great attention to. Through these projects, many families have been supported in order to provide them with a constant source of income that leads them to self-sufficiency. The Foundation carries out various projects in this field such as: project of providing goats and cows for households, Support and Empowerment of women - Small Enterprise Support Project).













### 2- Seasonal projects

In order to revive the spirit of social solidarity and promote the religious and societal values of Yemeni society, the Foundation targets poor and displaced families with seasonal projects every year, including the distribution of sacrificial meat and Eid clothes on the Eid Al-Fitr and Eid al-Adha events.

### **Emergency response and relief**

Most of Yemen's population face major challenges and difficulties in obtaining basic life services that help them to survive as a result of ongoing crises. The Foundation's important role in responding to emergencies and relief has emerged as a humanitarian duty that must be fulfilled.

#### 1- Water and Sanitation

In order to protect water from pollution and eliminate the phenomenon of defecation in the open areas, the foundation has applied a methodology of full sanitation led by the community within the framework of the project to provide integrated multisectoral assistance to local communities in order to eliminate this phenomenon and protect water from pollution and purifying it at the point of use and at home.

### 4- Health Projects

FHD focuses on health projects, which through several health projects contribute to improving the health situation and combating diseases and epidemics. The reproductive health project targets married and pregnant women to reduce the number of deaths due to complications of pregnancy and childbirth, raising the usage of reproductive health and family planning products. The Foundation has addressed many cases of women and children displaced through the "Mobile medical clinics project ) providing them with free of charge medicines
